

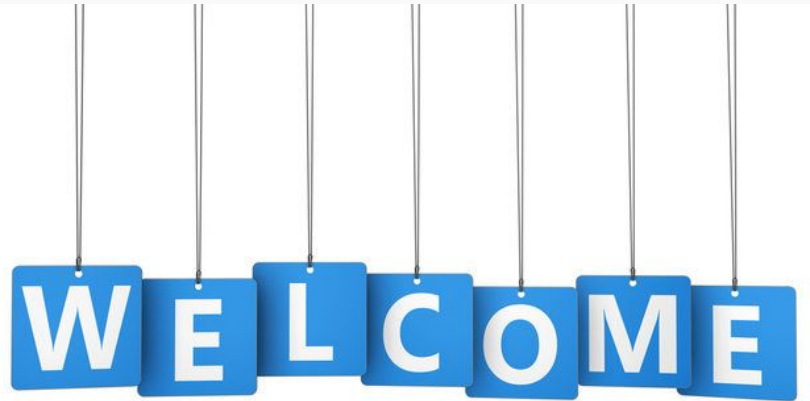

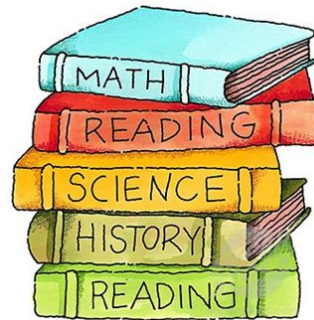

Assessments

Computer Adaptive - Comprehensive Interim Assessment (CIA)

Grades 3-5 beginning and middle of year assessments in reading/language arts and math.

WV General Summative Assessment (WVGSA)

Grades 3-5 state summative assessment in reading/language arts and math. This assessment is given in May.

Dibels

Grades K-2. Dibels is given 3 times per school year to monitor reading ability and monitor progress.

i-Ready

online assessment that helps teachers provide all students a path to proficiency and growth in mathematics.

Strategic Plan

The strategic plan is a document created for stakeholders including administrators, teachers, and parents. This document is used to review data and set goals for improvement in areas of need. Data and goals are reviewed annually. The strategic plan will be reviewed this year. Please watch for communication about when a meeting addressing the strategic plan will take place.



Strategic Plan Goals

Goal 1

By May of 2024, 22% of students will reach grade level on the iReady Math diagnostic assessment showing an increase of 10%.

In September 2023, 9 % of students were proficient on the BOY Benchmark. By January of 2024, 19% of students will reach proficiency on the MOY benchmark showing an increase of 10%.

Strategic Plan Goals

Goal 2

In September 2023, 42% of K - 3 students were proficient according to the Composite Score of the DIBELS test. By May of 2024, 52% of students will reach proficient according to the Composite Score of the DIBELS test, showing an increase of 10% for the year.

21% of the 3rd-5th grade students were proficient on the Fall Benchmark. Students in grades 3-5 will increase proficiency by 10% from the Fall Benchmark to the MOY Benchmark.

Strategic Plan Goals

Goal 3

Students will show a 2% growth from 44 % by the end of the 2023-2024 school year on the SEL Panorama survey for 3rd-5th grade students in the area of Emotion Regulation.

Increase parental involvement from having two Family Nights in 2022-2023 to 3 Family Nights in 2023-2024. Increase schoolwide student attendance rate from 93% in August to 95% in May.
